What to Think About Before Playing to the First Trick Whether You are Declarer or Defender

ALT-P

- A is for auction
- $L$ is for lead
- T is for Tricks
- $P$ is for plan
- Think about them all, they're all interrelated


## $A$ is for Auction

- What hidden gems are in the auction?
- Consider these four auctions.
- $1 \mathrm{~N}(P) 3 \mathrm{~N}$ all pass
- (P) P (P) 1N (P) 3N all pass
- (1D) $1 \mathrm{~N}(P) 3 \mathrm{~N}$ all pass
- 1S (1N) 4S all pass


## A is for Auction

- What hidden gems are in the K103 auction?
- Consider these three auctions.
- $1 \mathrm{~N}(P) 3 \mathrm{~N}$ all pass
- (P) $P(P) 1 N(P) 3 N$ all pass
- (1D) $1 \mathrm{~N}(P) 3 N$ all pass

## $A$ is for Auction

- What hidden gems are in the K9754 auction?
- Consider this auction:
- 1S (1N) 4S all pass
- Who has the queen of spades?

AJ1086

- How many spades does LHO have A942
- How do we deal with that? K5
- West has 16 HCP. Can she figure 98 out how many points her partner has at most?


## $L$ is for Lead

- What information is in the lead
- Ask opponents about their leads and carding
- Rule of 11 (4 $4^{\text {th }}$ best lead)
- What about honor card leads


## $L$ is for Lead

How are clubs probably divided? ..... A98
Can we afford to lose a finesse?J76

## $L$ is for Lead

Auction: ..... J9754

- 1S (1N) 4S all pass ..... 3
Lead: ..... QJ63
$3^{\text {rd }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ leads ..... K2
How many spades does LHO have? ..... AK1086
How many clubs does LHO have? ..... A942
What is your best chance to make the ..... K5 contract?
What can you try if it doesn't work?


## T is for Tricks

- Conventional Wisdom
- Count winners when in NT
- Count losers in suit contracts
- I recommend counting both


## $P$ is for Plan

- Develop your plan before playing to first trick even if dummy comes down with a singleton
- Deciding whether to win the first trick can be crucial
- Deciding which hand to win with can be crucial
- When defending, what do you lead when you win a trick?
- Use AL\&T in formulating your plan
